Headteachers Message

As I am writing the newsletter this week it is pouring with rain - I have my fingers crossed for some sunshine over the bank holiday weekend and hope you all enjoy it. Please remember that school is closed on Monday and we will see you on Tuesday 7th May.

We have had a calm week in school with our Year 6 children having their final rehearsal of the SATs week which will go ahead formally on Monday 13th May. The rest of the children in school have been wonderfully respectful of the need for quiet and orderly movement around the building which is excellent.

This week we have been successful in gaining a place on Surrey's 100 Nurturing Schools project. Participating in this project will build on the Attachment Aware and Trauma Informed Schools work that we launched with our staff in September and will encourage us to think about how we might further enhance the offer we make to all of our children.

Mrs. Gardner has also secured a place for Darley Dene in an Enhanced Language Communication Initiative (ELCi) and she will share details of this with families as soon as she has more details.

We welcomed Mrs. Gomez-Loez back to school this week and I wanted to thank Miss Huxley-Edwards and Mrs. Ali for the support they have given to the breakfast and afterschool club; it is wonderful to know that we have team members who will step-up to help when they can see that it will support our children and families.

Key Stage 1 update

Nursery have been drawing their special places this week and they have been threading daisies through chick shapes in the garden to strengthen their fine motor skills. In Key Stage 1, Year 1 have been comparing the animals that live in Kenya to those that live in the UK. They have also enjoyed washing and tasting different vegetables in preparation for making their vegetable kebabs. Chertsey museum visited us this week in year 2 and the children participated in a Victorian seaside workshop. They played some old fashioned games, created seashell art and looked at some Victorian seaside costumes.

Key Stage 2 update

This week, our Year 6 children have been working super hard ahead of their KS2 statutory assessments, which are approaching soon. Mrs Mackie has been blown away by their hard work and determination to achieve and we are all so proud of them. In Year 5, they have written a wonderful rainforest description using expanded noun phrases, literary techniques and a range of punctuation. They have loved publishing their writing into their journals that they have created to document Maia's journey in the 'Journey to the River Sea'. In Year 4, the children worked hard to create their very own Biographies on the environmentalist Wagari Maathai. The children really enjoyed carrying our their own research and applying this to their writing. The Year 3 children have been exploring money in their Maths lessons this week, where they have discovered that having more coins doesn't always equate to a higher value than fewer coins, leading to lessons in converting currency and employing various strategies for adding money.

Messages from the School Office

Safeguarding

Are the contact details we have for you up to date? This is a safeguarding issue. We need to have the contact details of at least 3 people we can ring in case of an emergency.

Absence

Please be advised that if children are taken out of school without authority, parents will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice, is £60.00 per parent/career, per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer, per child, so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices. Uniform

Please ensure that your child's uniform including Coats, Jackets and PE Kits as well as water bottles are named.

Lunch Boxes

Darley Dene is a **nut free** school. Please do not send your child to school with chocolate spread Sandwiches for lunch as it is not possible to distinguish between Nutella and a nut free chocolate spread. If your child has a chocolate spread sandwich we will call home to request that an alternative be brought in. Thank you for your co-operation.

Medication

If your child has been prescribed with medication which needs to be administered during the school day, please ensure that you complete a Pupil Medication Request form which can be found on the school's website or from the school office. Without the completed form staff will not be able to administer any medication.

Wrap Club

At Darley Dene we offer extended care at our breakfast and after school Wrap Clubs in order to support our families should they require it. Wrap Club is open to pupils in all year groups. At Wrap Club we have a variety of activities for the children to take part in.

- Play dough, puzzles, Rubik's games, book corner, kitchen area. Lego, bingo, transformers, costumes, construction, dominos, 4 in a row, cards, balloons, dolls. Engines, bowling and a wide selection of board games.
