

Maths

In Maths this term we are learning about colours, matching and sorting. We will focus on mixing colours to make a specific colour. The children will be going on colour hunts around the classroom and school, talking about the differences between the colours and which colours are their favourite. At the end of the term, we will consolidate all the work that has taken place over the past term.

Literacy

This term in Literacy the children will hear the story of 'A Superpower Like Mine', 'Hello Friend!' And 'What I Like About Me'. This year, we have continued to split our phonics group into three groups which we have found it to be most beneficial for the children. Group one will be revising and recapping on previous sounds learnt e.g. s/a/t/p/i/n. Group 2 and 3 will be working on phase 1- phase 4. The children will also be listening and learning the songs to 'Hello' song and '2 Little Dickie Birds'.

Communication and Language

We will retell the story of 'A Superpower Like Mine', 'Hello Friend!' And 'What I Like About Me', using colourful semantics as well as pictures, words and symbols to prompt us as well as acting it out. We also need to focus on using our words to ask for help when needed.

Expressive Art and Design

This term we will learn to create our own superhero masks, posters about things that we like and what makes us special and create a book about our life. The children will continue to express their art in a variety of ways including, junk modelling, paper mache to create their face, painting, drawing and role playing with their peers.

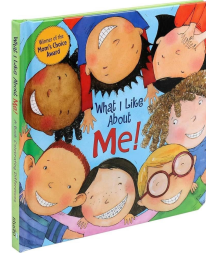
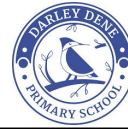
Personal Social and Emotional Development
