

Maths

This term we will cover place value, addition and subtraction, and shape. We will continue to practise counting, comparing and ordering numbers. As we dive deeper into our understanding of numbers, we will learn two fundamental maths operations of addition and subtraction, as well as discover more about 2D and 3D shapes. We will use manipulatives and everyday objects to fully grasp these concepts.

Art

Many artists use their own appearances and faces to extend the exploration of their art, creating some of the most well-known portraits of all time. This term we will draw inspiration from Frida Kahlo as we illustrate our own self-portraits.

Music

In Music, we will build an understanding of pulse when listening to a piece of music. We will improvise a simple rhythm and develop an understanding of melody, lyrics, and their importance to what we listen to. We will work together to see how instruments and players come together in an orchestra. This will enhance our skills for our Nativity performance.

Computing

We will dive into the world of technology and develop a further understanding of what information technology (IT) is all around us. This term we will investigate how IT improves our world and understand how to use IT responsibly. We will also discover different devices that capture photographs and learn how to capture, edit, and improve photos.

Geography

We will enhance our knowledge and understanding of the world, using a range of skills to explore human and physical features around us. This term we will examine four countries and capitals of the UK and venture to different continents and oceans around the world.

RE

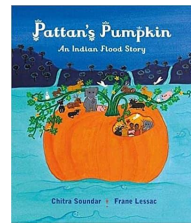
What is God like for Christians? Why do Christians call Jesus 'Saviour'? These are questions we will look to answer as we gain insight into different cultures and belief systems in RE.

English

We will develop our knowledge of grammar and punctuation, as well as speaking, reading, and writing skills. In writing, we will work to perfect our letter formation and our sentence mechanics to ensure we use capital letters and full stops. In reading, we will continue to apply phonic knowledge to decode as we work on our fluency and prosody. Our Reading Carousel sessions will also continue to answer a range of VIPER questions about what we are reading.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at animals including humans and being able to identify and classify them according to their features. We will also discover and identify uses of everyday materials through different objects, materials, and properties.

PE

In our P.E. lessons, we will work on our coordination, agility, and balance. Units this term are Send and Return, followed by Attack, Defend, Shoot. Our regular PE days are Monday and Friday.
