

Maths

In Maths this term we are learning about colours, matching and sorting. We will focus on mixing colours to make a specific colours. The children will be going on colour hunts around the classroom and school, talking about the differences between the colours and which colours are their favourite. At the end of the term, we will consolidate all the work that has taken place over the past term.

Literacy

This term in Literacy the children will hear the story of 'Owl Babies', Happy Birthday Maisie',and 'The Colour Monster'. We will be learning new rhymes each week to build vocabulary and memory. We will use rhymes to play games that introduce listening and speaking skills that are essential for phonics learning. The children will also be listening and learning the songs to 'Hello' song and '2 Little Dickie Birds'. Children who were here last year will be revisiting phonic sounds that were previously covered so they are ready to move on.

Communication and Language

We will use the power of reading texts , 'Owl Babies', 'Happy Birthday Maisie' and 'The Colour Monster' to build on the children's language. Planned activities will help the children understand vocabulary used in the stories. Adults will model spoken language for the children to developing ;grammar and conversation in English. We will learn lots of songs and rhymes that link to the themes in the books and focus on using words to ask for help when needed.

This term we will learn to draw about things that we like and what makes us special. The children will be allowed to experiment with a range of materials to express themselves through art in a variety of ways including, junk modelling, collage, painting, drawing and role playing with their peers. There will be lots of opportunities to dance to music from around the world and enjoy the different beats.

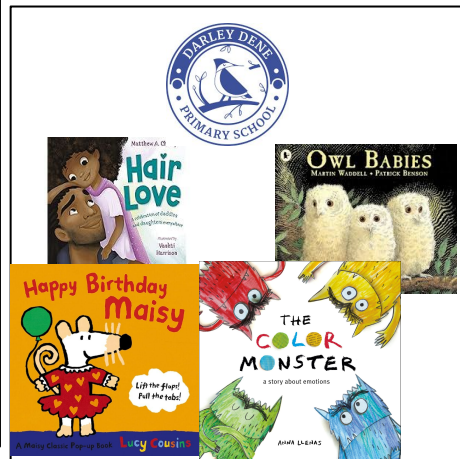
Personal Social and Emotional Development
