

Maths

This half term we will be developing our understanding of numbers 1 - 5 and deepening our substising skills.

We will be learning to:

- Represent, compose and compare numbers 1 - 5
- Recognise circles, triangles and sided shapes

We will provide the children with lots of practical activities using a range objects and providing them with opportunities to share why they have made that choice.

Literacy

We will continue to grow our knowledge on Phase 2 phonics sounds and will be practising our letter formation of these sounds in order to start writing and reading cvc words. This term we have a plethora of books that will help us understand why people celebrate different events and what makes them special. These books will inspire the children to engage in high quality discussions about the characters and themes of the book.

Communication and Language

Children are encouraged to use new vocabulary in different contexts as they play. We are encouraging questioning as we introduce question words, so the children can build upon known concepts to add depth in understanding.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be learning about colour mixing this half term. What colours make purple, orange and green? The children will be using their colour mixing skills to create their own artist impressions.

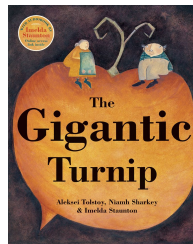
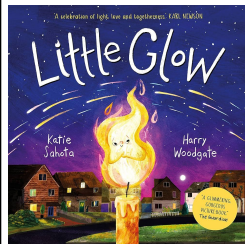
Personal Social and Emotional Development
