

Maths

In Maths we will be continuing to work on addition and subtraction, and starting multiplication and division. We will learn skills such as:

- Adding 2 and 3 digit numbers
- Subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers
- Learning the 3, 4, and 8 times tables
- Inverse operations
- Solving word problems

Art/DT

Children will explore basic sewing techniques including different stitches, materials, and the importance of safety while using sewing tools.

French

This half term we are learning how to name classroom objects and colours. We will also learn how to follow instructions in French.

Music

Year 3 will be exploring and developing playing skills through the glockenspiel as well as learning to read notated music.

Computing

Learners will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets. Next, they will apply those skills to create a story-based animation. This unit will conclude with learners adding other types of media to their animation, such as music and text.

Geography/History

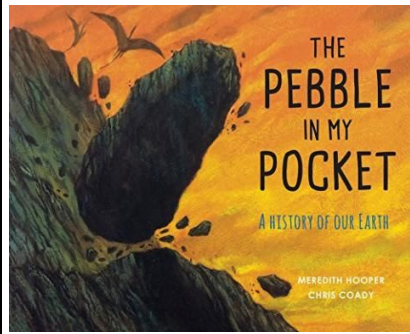

English

We will be reading the text: UG: The Genius Boy this half term. Using what we learn from the text as well as what we learn about the Stone Age, we will write a diary entry from the perspective of Ug. In our writing, we will show that we can use expanded noun phrases as well as accurate punctuation such as full stops and exclamation marks.

Science

In Science, our topic is Rocks and Soils. We will compare rocks based on physical features and study how they are formed. We will also have the opportunity to study the process of fossilization and explore the science behind paleontology.



PE
