

Maths - Length and Height, Mass, Capacity and Temperature

Children will explore measuring and comparing length, height, mass, capacity and temperature in practical contexts. They will develop their skills in using standard units, reading scales, and solving problems involving measurement. Through hands-on activities, pupils will gain confidence in applying measurement concepts to real-life situations. They will also learn to record and interpret their measurements, helping them understand the importance of accuracy and consistency.

DT - Making smoothies

Children will learn about healthy eating while designing and making their own fruit smoothies. They will explore different fruits, practise safe food preparation skills such as cutting and juicing, and evaluate their finished product. Through this process, pupils will develop their understanding of nutrition, hygiene and basic food technology skills.

Music - Inventing a musical story

Children will explore how music can be used to tell a story and express ideas and feelings. They will listen to a range of pieces, create their own musical ideas using instruments and voice, and work collaboratively to compose and perform a simple musical story.

Computing - Pictograms

In this unit, children will learn how to collect, organise and present data using pictograms. They will use simple digital tools to create pictograms, interpret the information shown, and answer questions about the data. Through practical activities, pupils will develop their understanding of how computers can help us sort and display information clearly.

History

This unit is about exploring why some people are remembered as significant individuals. Pupils will discover how Florence Nightingale improved nursing and hospital care, and how Rosa Parks' actions helped challenge unfair laws and bring about change. Through storytelling, discussion and simple historical enquiry, children will begin to understand how individuals can make a lasting difference in society.

RE

Children will explore what makes a good leader by learning about inspiring religious and non-religious figures and the values they demonstrate. Pupils will consider how positive leadership makes a difference in communities and how they can show these qualities in their own lives.

Year 2 - Spring 2

Power of Reading Texts:



English

In this unit, children will develop their writing skills through a range of engaging tasks, including writing a persuasive letter and a non-fiction piece about littering, and creating a descriptive piece about a garden. They will also practise writing interviews and informative texts about keeping our world clean and healthy. Through these activities, pupils will focus on using clear sentences, appropriate vocabulary, and ideas that engage and inform the reader.

Science

In this unit, children will explore how different animals live and survive in a variety of habitats, from oceans and forests to deserts and polar regions. Pupils will learn to identify and name a range of plants and animals, describing how they are suited to their environments. They will investigate microhabitats such as under logs, in leaf litter, and beneath stones, discovering the small creatures that live there and why. Through hands-on investigations and outdoor learning, children will develop their observation skills and begin to understand how living things depend on their habitats.

PE

Children will develop movement, coordination and teamwork through dance and ball games. They will explore rhythm and creative expression in dance, and practise throwing, catching, striking and running in Hit, Catch, Run activities.

PSHE - Healthy Me

Children will learn how to keep their bodies and minds healthy through topics such as healthy eating, exercise, rest, hygiene and staying safe. Through discussion and practical activities, they will develop confidence in making positive choices and understanding how to look after their own wellbeing.
