

Maths

In Maths this term we are continuing our learning about measurement. The children will compare different capacities and volumes, learn how to tell the time on an analogue clock to the nearest ten minutes and learn how to recognise the value of different coins.

We will then begin learning about fractions, recognise, finding, naming and writing fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.

Art/DT

This term our focus artist is Beatriz Milhazes. The children will be learning about printing and how to create patterns of lines, patterns of shapes and patterns of colour.

RE

The children will begin to understand that Muslims believe in one God, who they call Allah, and that Allah's 99 beautiful names express who Allah is for Muslims. The children will also build on prior learning through exploring and comparing how different religious communities pray, and to consider why other people choose not to pray.

English

This term we are learning how to create, write and perform a poem based on our class text. The children will also focus on nonfiction writing. They will be analysing the key features of a letter and they will be producing a review of their (in-class) trip to the seaside.

History

In History this term, the children will be locating coastal areas around the UK and learning about how people in modern day Britain enjoy the seaside. They will then compare this to how the people of the Victorian era enjoyed the seaside and answer some key questions:

Why did Victorian people go to the seaside? What clothes did Victorians wear at the seaside? What could you do at the seaside during the Victorian period?

Music

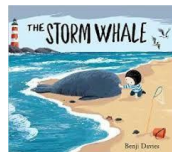
In music this term the children will be exploring a musical sound, building on their knowledge of rhythm, beat and pulse.

PSHE
