

Maths

When looking at our Fractions unit, we will:

- Add and subtract fractions.
- Answer reasoning questions using fractions.
- Problem solving using fraction walls and word problems.

When looking at our Money unit, we will:

- Recognise amounts of money.
- Add and subtract amounts of money.
- Compare amounts of money.
- Answer multi-step problems involving amount of money.

Art/DT

Learners this term will be making bread. This topic will involve research, taste-tasting, and then lots of practice of the skills and knowledge needed to make delicious bread.

Food technology skills are essential for helping creating young people with confident life skills.

French

We will be learning the names of relationships within a family and learning to describe our families in French.

RE

Islam: How does 'ibadah' (worship) show what is important to Muslims? Learners will explore ways in which Muslims worship, why Muslims worship, and the importance of worship to everyday Muslim life.

Computing

Learners will experiment with computer software with the aim of sequencing music and composing their own songs using a range of different instruments. Learners will be able to sequence layers of different instruments with different pitches and volume. Learners will be able to apply previous knowledge and e-literacy onto a new platform and create exciting sounds for a range of audiences.

Geography/History

This term in Geography, we will be learning about cities in Europe: where they are located, what they are famous for, and creating fact files that celebrate their unique heritage.

Music

The focus this term is in improvisation and learners adapting their own ideas into new pieces of music.

English

As we follow the story, we will make fact files, create exciting stories set in ferocious rainforests, setting descriptions, and more! Learners will be focusing on applying the skills they have learnt in Year 3 so far, such as expanded noun phrases, speech, paragraphs, and subordinate conjunctions. At learners approach the end of Year 3, the focus is on increasing stamina for writing and creating longer pieces of writing.

Learners will empathise with the animals of the forest as they try to put themselves into the different perspectives and arguments of the animals and people who use the rainforest.

Science

This term, Year 3 will be exploring the science topic *Light*. This topic will explore types of sources, how they are formed, and the dangers of too much sun on our bodies. Learners will also experiment using light sources and investigate how light travels.

PE

This term, students will develop their skills in athletics. This exciting topic will give learners an opportunity to exercise different muscles and skills in a range of games and competitions.

PSHE

This term we will be learning how relationships online can be safe and unsafe. It is very important we are aware of the rules on online communities and the measures you need to take to keep yourself safe.
