

English

This term we will be reading *Azzi in Between* by Sarah Garland. It follows the story of Azzi - a young girl who has to suddenly leave her home country due to conflict and become a refugee. She faces the challenges that come with moving to new places, but also learns how gardening can be a way to find familiarity in the unfamiliar.

We will be writing diaries, missing chapters, and instructional manuals on growing beans to help us explore the character and her journey.



Maths

Through our 'Decimals' unit, we will work on:

- Exploring fractions and decimals equivalent to tenths, quarters and halves
- Comparing and ordering numbers with one or two decimal places
- Rounding decimals to the nearest whole number
- Multiplying and dividing decimals by 10 and 100

We will also continue to prepare for the MTC checks which take place in Summer 2!

French

'On Mange' will be our topic this term, where we will explore how to say our favorite food in french!

Science

This term in Science we will be learning about Animals Including Humans, focusing specifically on food chains. In this science unit, pupils explore food chains and learn how living things depend on one another for survival. They identify producers, consumers, and predators, and begin to understand how energy is transferred within a habitat.

Computing

This half term, we will continue to develop our coding skills using Scratch. We will specifically be learning to design and write programs that accomplish specific goals, while also being able to identify and correct errors in algorithms and programming.

Religious Education

This term we will be introduced to Humanism and exploring the topic: How do Humanists celebrate new life?

Music

In this topic, we will be listening to music from different traditions and composers. We will then be using this music as inspiration in order to create our own unique musical compositions.

Geography

This half term, our learning will be based around the beautiful country of Iceland. In this geography unit, pupils will develop their locational knowledge by identifying Iceland's position within Europe and the wider world, using maps, atlases, and digital tools. We will explore key physical and human features of Iceland, building an understanding of its geographical context and how it compares to other regions. Finally, we will explore what makes Iceland unique, from volcanoes to fermented shark!

Physical Education

This term we are focusing on Athletics. Pupils develop their skills in running, jumping, and throwing through a range of engaging athletic activities. They learn to accelerate over short distances, use one-footed take-offs, and apply techniques such as the sling action for discus and baton exchanges in relay races.

Design Technology

This half term we will be using paper mache in order to make out very own Volcanoes! We will be exploring the process of shaping, joining, and finishing materials, while developing practical making skills and an understanding of simple structures.

PSHE

This half term, we will be exploring relationships and discussing how we can develop positive relationships around us. We will be thinking how we can apply this knowledge into real life situations.
