

Maths

In Maths this term we are learning about number composition. Making the number 3 and 4 in lots of different ways e.g. 3 and 0, 2 and 1 etc. We will be looking at numbers that become before and after certain numbers using a number track/number line and building our own number lines. We will also be looking again at numbers to 5, but solving problems with these numbers. Then we will consolidate all the work that we have done this half term in maths.

Literacy

This term in Literacy the children will hear the story of the The 3 Billy Goat's Gruff, The Gingerbread Man, and the 3 Little Pigs. We have spilt our phonics group into two groups. Group one who are heading to Reception in September will looking at the final sounds from the Little Wandle programme, along with fine tuning their rhyming skills, clapping of syllables and hearing words that start with the same first sound (mummy, mouth, monster etc.. Group 2 learn a range of familiar songs from the Little Wandle programme and will practice '5 currant buns' and "Ring-a-roses".

Communication and Language

We will retell the story of our Power of reading texts using dressing up and props in the roleplay areas both indoors and out.. We will also build on our mark making and writing skills in readiness for those moving up to include name writing with some correct letter formation.

Expressive Art and Design

This term we will learn to build models. We will use junk modelling to build bridges for the Billy Goats to cross and houses for the Little Pigs. We will also use a range of other resources such as stickle bricks, large blocks, bricks, milk crates, planks and open ended building materials indoors and out to make props for retelling stories. We will make masks and use them to take on the role of different characters.

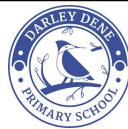
In music and dance we will make up movements and songs to retell the stories.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

In PSHE this term we will be learning all about Changing Me and coping positively to change. We will label the outline of a body and sing 'Heads, Shoulders, Knees and Toes.' As well as learning all about respecting our bodies, growing up, growth and change, fun and fears and celebration. We will also be focusing on Zones of regulation. The children will have daily activities linking to how they are feeling and why they might feel like that. .
