

**Maths** This term in Maths the children will be learning how to tell the time on an analogue clock. They will be learning how to read o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to and then to the nearest 5 minutes. The children will also be learning about capturing data for basic statistics using tally charts, tables, block diagrams and pictograms. Finally, the children will be consolidating all of their learning this year with an emphasis on reasoning and problem solving skills.

**DT** This term in DT the children will be learning about mechanical structures. They will be creating their own moving picture using levers and will be responsible for researching, designing and evaluating their own product.

**PSHE - Changing Me**  
The children are learning about natural changes that occur in our bodies as we age. They will discuss how that makes them feel and learn strategies to manage their emotions.

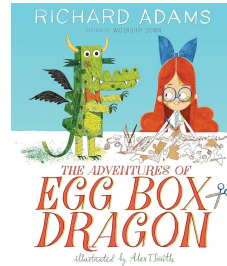
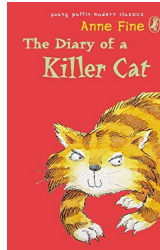
**Music**  
This term the children are exploring improvisation with a range of different musical instruments.

**Computing**  
**Programming Quizzes**  
This term the children will be developing their coding skills on ScratchJr. They will be learning about how to generate their own quiz and will select the backgrounds and characters for their own projects.

**Geography**  
This term the children will be learning about human and physical features in urban and rural landscapes. They will identify the features of both landscapes, discuss the benefits and negatives of living in a rural or urban area and identify different urban and rural landscapes in the UK on a map. The children will also learn about how the land is used, including the different aspects of farming.

**RE**  
Children will be learning about the importance of the Quran for Muslim families and learn about the characteristics of the prophet Muhammed (PBUH) They will also discuss how to be a role model in their local community.

**English**  
The children are focusing this term on using a range of different vocabulary in their writing to suit the formality and genre of the piece. They are going to consult their knowledge of modal verbs and use them in an instructional piece of writing. The children are also going focus on accurately editing their learning to make revisions, corrections and enhancements to their piece of writing. The children will focus on letter formation and will have to opportunity to practice their cursive handwriting in preparation for KS2.

**Science**  
Habitats and Microhabitats  
The children will learn about different habitats and which animals and plants reside there. They will also answer key questions including

- What is a habitat?
- What is a microhabitat?
- How can I tell if something is dead or alive?

During this unit the children will also learn about how animals are suited to their environment.



**PE**  
This term the children will be focusing on athletics and gymnastics. The children will learn how to run for distance and perform a basic sequence of jumps, rolls and holds.
