

Maths

In Maths we will be working on place value as well as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will learn skills such as:

- Representing numbers to 1000
- Partitioning numbers to 1000
- Adding 2-digit and 3-digit numbers
- Using the 2, 5, and 8 times tables

Art/DT

In Art this term, we are focussing on creating clay sculptures in the style of the artist Alberto Giacometti. We will explore a variety of techniques and materials to understand how Giacometti created his own pieces.

French

This half term we are learning how to say hello and goodbye in French. As well as how to speak conversationally including how to ask "How are you?".

Music

Where did music begin? When did it start? How has it evolved? What does it mean to us? We will be exploring all of these ideas this term.

Computing

During this unit, children will become familiar with the terms 'input', 'process', and 'output'. We will be learning about how computers are connected and what makes a digital device.

Geography/History

This term in History, we will be exploring the Stone Age. We will learn about what life was like for humans during this time period and explore similarities and differences in our modern lives in the areas of socialisation, education, building structures, and technology.

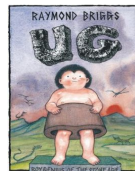
RE

Science

In Science, our topic is Animals Including Humans - Skeleton and Muscles. We will learn about the skeletal structure of a human as well as animals focusing on the terms vertebrate and invertebrate. We will learn about how to keep our bones and muscles healthy and what can happen if we don't.

PE

This half term is all about tag rugby. We will practice the skills needed for the game in various exercises as well as learn to play tag rugby.

English

We will be reading the text: UG: The Genius Boy this half term. Using what we learn from the text as well as what we learn about the Stone Age, we will write a diary entry from the perspective of Ug. In our writing, we will show that we can use expanded noun phrases as well as accurate punctuation such as full stops and exclamation marks.
