This half term we are learning how to describe ourselves and others while building upon our vocabulary.

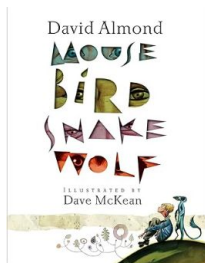
PE

Science

English
