

Maths

In Maths this term we will be consolidating our number and digit knowledge to 10 while also exploring the different ways you can use addition to build numbers. We look deeper into the concept of zero and how even though it means “nothing” it is still called a number.

Alongside this number knowledge the children will be exploring length and capacity through play and deliberate lessons imbedding the mathematical language around measurement.

Literacy

You are super! You can do anything you put your mind to. In literacy this term we are exploring stories about people doing great things. In phonics we are beginning our Phase 3 sounds and reading longer words.

In writing the children are exploring sentence writing while continuing to build on their segmenting skills when writing longer words.

Communication and Language

Children are encouraged to use new vocabulary in different contexts as they play. We are encouraging questioning as we introduce question words, so the children can build upon known concepts to add depth in understanding.

Expressive Art and Design

This term the children are encouraged to extend storylines in their imaginative play. As we explore different jobs and people who help us, the children will have opportunities to play and explore being in these roles.

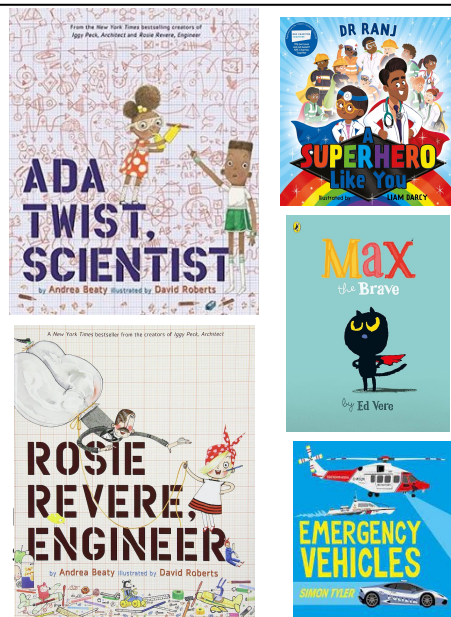
At the art table we are working collaboratively, exploring mosaics and Gaudi.
