

Maths

This half term we will cover:
Recall of the two times table
Dividing by grouping
Dividing by sharing
Recognising odd and even numbers
Halving and doubling
10 times table, including dividing by 10.
5 times table, including dividing by 5.
Measuring in cm and m
Comparing different lengths and heights
Using the four operations with lengths and heights.

DT

We will be learning about healthy and unhealthy food choices. Children will be sampling and then selecting a range of fruits for a smoothie. They will also be responsible for designing and promoting their product.

Music

Inventing a musical story.
In this unit the children will be learning to sing with a clear voice and listen and respond in time to a steady beat

Computing

We will be learning to about the term 'data'. The children will begin to understand what data means and how this can be collected in the form of a tally chart. They will learn the term 'attribute' and use this to help them organise data. They will then progress onto presenting data in the form of pictograms and finally block diagrams.

History

Historical figures: Children will be learning about the term 'significant' and how someone becomes significant. They will learn about the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and compare the lasting impact these two women had on their community and on a global scale.

RE

For RE this term, we will be discussing what makes a good leader. We are going to be analysing the role of influential religious figures on their communities and the wider world, and we will explore what makes a good leader in the children's lives and around our school.

Year 2 - Spring 2 The Secret Sky Garden

Power of Reading Text:



English

In English this term we are learning about imperative 'bossy verbs' and three different sentence types: command, questions and statements. The children are practising rehearsing their sentences out loud to identify errors and enhance their ideas before recording them in their books. They are going to use expanded noun phrases and similes in their writing when describing settings and characters linked to our power of reading text: The the Secret Sky Garden

Science

In Science, we will be learning about the basic needs of humans to survive. The children are going to describe the importance of exercise for humans and are learning about the impact of eating a nutritious and varied diet. They are also going to describe the importance of maintaining good hygiene.

PE Hit, Catch, Run

IN PE we are developing sending and receiving skills to help us field when playing team games.
We are going to be learning to strike the ball with a range of different bats and we are discussing the key principles of sportsmanship.

PSHE: Healthy Me

As part of this unit, children will learn how to keep their bodies healthy and how to make informed choices. We will focus on what it's like to feel relaxed and how feeling stressed makes our body feel.
