# Maths

This term we will be looking at addition and subtraction within 20 and place value to 50. The children will be ordering numbers to 20, gaining confidence using a number line and the part part whole model to solve problems. They will be using strategies such as counting back and finding the difference. They will also cover looking at doubles and near doubles and

missing number problems.

## Art

We will be investigating Sculpture and the children will be using different techniques and creating their own sculptures in the style of Barbara Hepworth. They will be discussing their views and opinions of her work.

## RE The children will learn that the Torah is

the Jewish holy book and contains rules to help Jewish people live good lives. They will discuss and develop their understanding on what it means to treat something with respect. They will also explore the Synagogue, where the Torah is kept and where Jewish people go to pray.

# Computing

Children will develop their understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text. They will become more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text. Children will consider how to change the look of their text, and will be able to justify their reasoning in making these changes.

## History

We begin our History topic by exploring and understanding Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin's achievements and the famous moon landing. The children will also develop their knowledge of Mae Jemison and her role in space history. They will gain an understanding of events beyond their living memory and view a range of photos, stories and videos from the past.

## Music

The children will be exploring chime bars and playing along to songs. They will be exploring their own compositions and performing to each other.
