

Maths

In Maths this term we will be exploring numbers beyond 10. We will use stem sentences such as “I can see 1 ten ____ and ____” and “____ and ____ makes ____”. As our knowledge of numbers to 20 is consolidated we will then look at the composition and decomposition of 2D shapes.

Literacy

This term we will be exploring texts about the habitat that is the ocean, the creatures who live and the plants that grow there. We are building up the childrens stamina in writing sentences more regularly and with confidence. In phonics we are building on reading longer words with the phonemes already learnt throughout the year so far.

Communication and Language

Children are encouraged to use new vocabulary in different contexts as they play. We are encouraging questioning as we introduce question words, so the children can build upon known concepts to add depth in understanding.

Expressive Art and Design

In Art this term we are exploring colour mixing, looking at primary and secondary colours. Children will be encouraged to retell stories through the use of role play, puppets and toys. We will also be encouraging children to extend storylines in student initiated role play.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

In PHSE we will be looking at relationships we have with family and friends as we celebrate difference and being our own best friend in celebrating ourselves. The children will continue to build on their resilience and talking and understanding their own feelings and those of others, finding ways to bring themselves to calm when over excited or upset by something.

Understanding the World

As we come into Summer we will be looking at how the seasons have changed throughout the year. In our Under the Sea exploration the children will become Marine Biologists and learn about similarities and differences in different undersea animals and vegetation. Physical Development

As the children’s fine motor skills are strengthening they will continue to use different tools for writing and create art for longer periods of time to build stamina.

In Physical Education lessons, children will be building on their speed and agility through fundamental movement skills.
