Maths

This term we will be exploring our knowledge of geometry in shape and position and direction. We will delve into the fluency, reasoning and problem solving areas. During this topic we will be exploring these questions:

What is an Angle and how do you classify angles?

What do we use to measure angles? How do we calculate different angles in different places?

What are the properties of 3D shapes? The children will also develop their knowledge on plotting and reading coordinates and translating shapes on a graph.

Art/DT

We will be creating art inspired by Giuseppe Arcimboldo. He was an Italian painter best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of objects such as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish and books.

Music

We will be developing our skills on the ukulele by learning how to play a combination of notes and challenging ourselves to play different pieces of music.

Computing

In this unit, learners will use physical computing to explore the concept of selection in programming through the use of the Crumble programming environment.

French

Where is your favourite place to go on holiday? Do you enjoy going to the beach or the pool? Our topic 'En vacances' will teach us to give opinions, direction and facts about going on holiday.


Geography

English

Science
